- Gaza's Health Ministry reported 73,356 Palestinians killed and 174,185 injured since 7 October 2023, while OCHA projected that 67 per cent of Gaza's population would face Crisis or worse food insecurity between July and December 2026. - OHCHR verified at least 293 civilians killed and 1,990 injured in Ukraine in June; separately, a UN release reported Russian authorities' first-half 2026 claim of 250 civilians killed and 1,596 injured in Russia. MIDDLE EAST

Gaza Strip

Gaza's Health Ministry reported 73,356 Palestinians killed and 174,185 injured since 7 October 2023 as of 2 August. It also reported 1,230 killed and 4,076 injured since the October 2025 ceasefire. [WAFA](#) (Palestinian official)

OCHA projected that 67 per cent of Gaza's population would face Crisis or worse food insecurity between July and December 2026. Its 31 July report also described continuing humanitarian constraints and a high level of settler-related violence in the West Bank.

West Bank

OCHA reported that 1,109 Palestinians, including 243 children, had been killed by Israeli forces or settlers in the West Bank since 7 October 2023 as of the end of June. It also reported more than 2,300 Palestinians displaced across the West Bank in 2026 because of settler attacks and related access restrictions. [OCHA oPt \(3 July 2026\)](#)

OCHA later recorded more than 1,380 settler-related incidents across the West Bank in 2026 and reported that July was jointly the deadliest month for Palestinians in such incidents since October 2023. [OCHA oPt](#) (UN/humanitarian)

Lebanon

UN News reported that UNIFIL recorded 125 Israeli airspace violations over Lebanon between Thursday and Sunday, amounting to more than 418 combined hours of overflight. The report also described continuing civilian impact from regional hostilities and attacks in Gaza. [UN News](#) (UN agency)

Iran–US

U.S. Central Command said it struck dozens of IRGC targets in Iran on 29 July, describing the action as a response to attempted Iranian missile attacks on U.S. forces.

Al Jazeera reported that President Trump said new talks would begin, while an Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman said Iran was not hosting or visiting a delegation at that time. It reported that Iran-Oman discussions were focused on Strait of Hormuz management; the timing and form of any U.S.-Iran negotiation therefore remained uncertain. EASTERN EUROPE

Russia–Ukraine Conflict

OHCHR verified at least 293 civilians killed and 1,990 injured in Ukraine in June 2026. It counted 2,226 civilian casualties in territory controlled by Ukraine and 57 in territory occupied by the Russian Federation; the location totals are not separately disaggregated into killed and injured in the monthly report. Russian Perspective: RT, citing Saratov's governor, reported two civilians killed and several wounded after a Ukrainian drone attack in Saratov Region on 2 August, and said the Defence Ministry reported 635 intercepted Ukrainian drones across 16 regions overnight. A United Nations in Ukraine release separately reported the Russian authorities' first-half 2026 claim of 250 civilians killed and 1,596 injured in Russia. These are attributed Russian accounts. AFRICA

Sudan

OCHA reported escalating violence in North Kordofan, damage to critical civilian infrastructure, and continuing explosive-ordnance risks for families attempting to return. It described a severe crisis for children amid violence, disrupted services, and growing humanitarian needs. [OCHA Sudan](#) (*UN/humanitarian*)

ACLED recorded more than 50 drone strikes and more than 110 reported fatalities in North Kordofan during June, and assessed the state as a central arena of contestation between the RSF and SAF. Cumulative death counts are highly uncertain: a July UK

government report gave an indicative 20,000–150,000 range and noted that ACLED's 52,904 recorded fatalities were undercounts; ACLED likewise describes its dataset as a conservative minimum of direct conflict deaths. ASIA

Myanmar

OCHA reported more than 16 million people in need and nearly 3.8 million displaced across Myanmar. Armed hostilities, movement restrictions, and administrative requirements continued to impede humanitarian access, while only 43 per cent of the US\$890 million response requirement had been funded. UNHCR's operational data portal recorded 3,997,600 internally displaced people in Myanmar as of 27 July 2026, underscoring the continuing scale of displacement. [UNHCR Operational Data Portal](#) (*UN agency*)
